MEMBERSHIP GUIDELINES

Application Requirements:

- Nominee must be a homeschool student
- Nominee must have a 3.5 grade point average and must supply a transcript with his/her application
- Nominee must provide proof of test scores from **one** of the following tests:
 - CLT- 88, CLT 10- 97, CLT 8 (97)
 - SAT- 1200
 - ACT- 26, Pre-ACT 10- 26
 - PSAT- 1200, PSAT 10- 1170, PSAT 8/9- (8th Grade 1020) (9th grade 1090)
 - 90% composite score on the Iowa or 90% on the total battery (the score listed under the National PR-S column) on the Stanford
 - Tera Nova 2 (CAT6) 2nd Ed. – 90% total score
 - All test scores must be administered by someone other than the parent.
 - Test scores should not be more than 1 year old
- Nominee must submit an essay of 200-400 words describing their faith in Christ and the gifts/talents God has given them to share with the group.
- Nominee must complete and submit an application form.
- Nominee must be at least 14 years of age.

Commitment Requirements:

- **Attend the MANDATORY Induction Ceremony September 10, 2022**
- Actively participate in at least two ESA public service projects per year
- Schedule and organize at least one public service project for our chapter per year
- Attend monthly chapter meetings (most are via Zoom)
- Act as a liaison for ESA to let others know about our organization
- Uphold the ideals of leadership and service
- Maintain high scholastic and social standards
